

Grouping DEPPA accounts for dentists in your practice

Each dentist has their own DEPPA account and thus their own list of the patients they have assessed. However, if you wish to view / repeat assessments of patients previously assessed by a colleague you can optionally group your dentists' DEPPA accounts together. This enables you to:

- transfer a DEPPA record over if a dentist retires or a patient is seen by a different dentist within the practice;
- compare patients' scores across different clinicians for audit purposes, and
- enable other practice members to view DEPPA reports completed by all dentists.

Once set up, you will see tabs on the Adult and Young Patients page for your colleagues where you can view their DEPPA patient list.

If you want to undertake a repeat assessment on a patient previously assessed by another dentist in your practice, you must first reassign them to your account using the reassign patient drop down highlighted on the image below.

Please note:

- You cannot modify assessments created by other dentists or view their unfinished assessments.
- The header of prior reports remains the same on transfer, i.e. it will show the original dentist who prepared it.
